



SEASONAL OCEAN LIFEGUARD

Compensation: \$10.54 to 12.81 Lifeguard (*placement may be at any level in the range*)

Requirements:

- ✓ Successful completion of the San Diego Regional Academy, including completion of Introduction to Open Water Lifeguarding and American Red Cross Emergency Response.
- ✓ Possession of valid C.P.R for the Professional Rescuer Card (included in the Red Cross Emergency Response Certificate).
- ✓ Possession of Basic Ocean Lifesaving Certificate (additional experience may be considered in lieu of this requirement).
- ✓ Knowledge of ocean shoreline currents and conditions; ocean rescue and safety procedures.
- ✓ Must be 18 years of age by date of hire.
- ✓ Must be a U.S. citizen or have appropriate documentation that you have the legal right to work in the U.S and possess a valid Social Security Card/ Number.
- ✓ Vision must be 20/40 uncorrected, correctable to 20/20.
- ✓ Functional color vision and normal hearing.
- ✓ Have the physical strength, endurance and ability required for swimming, running, walking, standing, or sitting for extended periods of time.

Recruitment Process:

- ✓ Successfully complete an oral interview.
- ✓ At the interview, complete a Solana Beach City Employment Application (or bring a completed application with you, which can be accessed on the City Website).
- ✓ Possess and bring with you to the interview, a valid driver's license.
- ✓ Successful completion of a 10-minute or less, 500 meter open water swimming test
- ✓ Successfully pass a pre-employment medical examination, which will include a drug screening.
- ✓ Successful completion of a background check and fingerprint criminal history check.
