 - Energy Management Plan (SANDAG Energy Roadmap) for All Municipal Buildings (2009)
 - Council unanimously approves 1st ever GHG Inventory (2009)
 - City installs first SDG&E approved LED streetlights in SD County (2010)
 - City joins CaliforniaFIRST PACE program (2010)
 - Council adopted “Vision for Environmental Sustainability” (2011)

 - Council approves ESCO public/private partnership to upgrade City facilities (lighting, HVAC and retrofit over 500 streetlights to LED) (2012)
 - Plastic Bag Reduction Ordinance -1st in SD County) (2012)
 - Polystyrene Ban - 1st in SD County (2015)
 - Council approval of Comprehensive Active Transportation Strategies (CATS) (2015)
 - Council approval of the “Emerging Cities Program” partnership with SDG&E to fund EPIC to update the City’s GHG Inventory (2015)
 - Council signs onto the “Compact of Mayors” (2015)
